Let the Holy Spirit Lead

Be attentive to the Holy Spirit's promptings. Rely not on your own understanding, but seek divine wisdom.

This is a Space for You

Come as you are. There's no need to hide. The more you open your heart and embrace transparency, the more you will gain from the Forum experience.

Confidentiality is Essential

Listen with an open heart and seek understanding before forming opinions. Everything shared in the Forum must remain confidential. Breaching confidentiality is grounds for immediate dismissal.

Speak the Truth with Grace

Encourage and equip one another with gentleness and respect. This is not a place to "win" but to grow.

Embrace a Teachable Spirit

Be open to giving and receiving feedback. Ask yourself: *Is anything in my life out of alignment with Scripture? Am I willing to be challenged by those who want to see me grow?*

Be Concise & Stay Relevant

Honor the time and contributions of others. Share your thoughts concisely and keep stories & insights applicable to the discussion.

Be Fully Present

Engage actively—listen not just to words, but to what is unspoken. Eliminate distractions: put aside work, mute devices, refrain from unrelated typing, and keep your camera on whenever possible for full engagement.

No Business Solicitation

Let relationships develop naturally. If someone inquires about your business or services, continue the conversation outside the Forum. Do not initiate "sales" discussions.

Honor the Time Commitment

Arrive on time and stay for the entire meeting. If you can't attend or must leave early, notify your facilitator in advance.

Leave Transformed

Commit to applying what you learn. The goal is not just discussion—it's transformation.
